FLIGHT RESTRICTION NOTICE

SAFETY REGULATION DIVISION IRISH AVIATION AUTHORITY THE TIMES BUILDING 11-12 D'OLIER STREET DUBLIN 2

Flight Restriction Over Cusack Park, Ennis, County Clare, Sunday April 20th, 2025

The Irish Aviation Authority in pursuance of Articles 7 & 10 of the Irish Aviation Authority (Rules of the Air) Order, 2019 (S.I. No. 266 of 2019), and in accordance with European Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 923 of 2012, SERA.3145 (Prohibited Areas and Restricted Areas), hereby directs as follows:-

A temporary restriction (Temporary Restricted Area) on the flying of Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) as defined in S.I. No. 24 of 2023 and Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/947, shall apply over Cusack Park, Ennis, County Clare in the airspace contained within the under mentioned:

Lateral limits: A circle radius of 1NM centred on:

52° 50' 48.10" N, 008° 58' 42.35" W

Vertical limits: SFC to 5000FT AMSL

Duration: From 0900hrs UTC to 1700hrs UTC on the 20th April 2025.

The purpose of the TRA is to allow the Clare v Cork Munster Hurling Championship match to take place while safeguarding the safety of competitors and spectators from distraction or interference from aviation activities over Cusack Park, Ennis, County Clare in the period cited.

The airspace contained within the TRA is ICAO Class C.

Point of contact during activation is Ennis Garda Station +353 (0)86 833 9559.

Subject to any decision by the Irish Aviation Authority to the contrary, the airspace within the TRA is restricted to use by UAS authorised by An Garda Síochána.

Unmanned Aircraft Systems may be subject to seizure by An Garda Síochána as evidence for potential prosecution and in the interest of aviation safety.

Any exemptions, alleviations, or permissions granted to Unmanned Aircraft Systems operators by the Authority, are not valid within this TRA during the period cited.

A NOTAM will be issued in due course to notify of the TRA activation.
